

PRIVACY POLICY

In compliance with the provisions within the meaning and effect of art. 13 Legislative Decree 30 June 2003, the data controller, Megamente S.r.l. with offices in (51016) Montecatini Terme (PT), Via San Marco 33, informs users of the QOOID PORTAL of the purposes and methods of processing of personal data collected, its scope of communication and dissemination, as well as the nature of its disclosure.

DATA HANDLED

Navigation Data:

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, certain personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of internet communication protocols.

This is information that is not collected to be associated to specific individuals, but by its very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, lead to the identification of users.

This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of those computers used by users who connect to the site, URI notation addresses (*Uniform Resource Identifier*) of requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in reply, the numerical code indicating the status of the data response from the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters regarding the operating system and computer environment of the User.

The data thus collected could be used to ascertain liability in the event of any computer crimes against damages of the site.

Data supplied directly by the user

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of data as required by various sections of this site is used in order to pursue the requests of the user (such as merely indicative and not exhaustive: if information or explanations are requested by telephoning the numbers listed on the site or by writing to the e-mail addresses therein).

Specific summary information will be reported on the pages of the Portal set up for the services, so as to draw the attention of the party concerned to the processing of their personal data.

NATURE OF DISCLOSURE OF DATA

Except for navigation data, needed to facilitate the computer and data protocols, the disclosure of personal data by users is free and optional. However, failure to provide this data will make it impossible to process the requests made or that the user intends to submit.

METHOD OF PROCESSING

Data processing is performed via computer media. The data is stored within paper and electronic files with the adoption of the minimum security measures provided by law.

COOKIES

No personal user data is taken from the site.

No use of cookies is made to transmit information of a personal nature, nor are so-called persistent cookies of any kind, or systems for tracing users employed.

The use of so-called session cookies (which are not permanently stored on the user's computer and disappear when the browser is closed) is strictly limited to transmitting session identifiers (made up of random numbers generated by the server) necessary to enable safe and efficient exploration of the site.

The so-called session cookies used on this site avoid the use of other computer technologies that could compromise the privacy of the navigation of users and do not allow the acquisition of personal identification data of the user.

COMMUNICATION AND DISSEMINATION

The data collected will not be distributed, sold or exchanged with any third party without the express consent of the party concerned, except

for any communications required to perform the services requested. The data may also be communicated to the competent authorities, under the terms of the law.

RIGHTS OF THE PARTY CONCERNED

The party concerned may assert their rights as expressed by arts. 7, 8, 9 and 10 of Legislative Decree 30 June 2003 no. 196 by contacting the data controller. In particular, in accordance with art. 7, the party concerned may obtain confirmation of the existence or absence of personal data concerning them, even if not yet registered and its communication in intelligible form. The party concerned has the right to obtain indication: a) of the origin of the personal data b) of the purposes and methods of processing c) of the logic applied in case of processing with the aid of electronic instruments d) of the identity of the holder, of the managers and representative appointed under article 5, paragraph 2; e) of the subjects or categories of persons to whom the personal data may be communicated or who may learn thereof as appointed representative in the territory of the state, managers or appointees. The party concerned has the right to obtain: a) an update, rectification or, where there is an interest, the integration of data, b) the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed unlawfully, including that which does not need to be kept for the purposes for which the data was gathered or subsequently processed c) certification that the operations in letters "a" and "b" were brought to the attention, also as regards their content, of those to whom the data was communicated or published, except in the case where such fulfilment is impossible or involves a use of means that is obviously disproportionate to the right protected. The party concerned has the right to oppose, in whole or in part, a) for legitimate reasons to the processing of personal data concerning them, even for the purpose of collection; b) to the processing of personal information for purposes of sending advertising or direct sales materials or for carrying out market research or commercial communications.
